

## Travel instruction

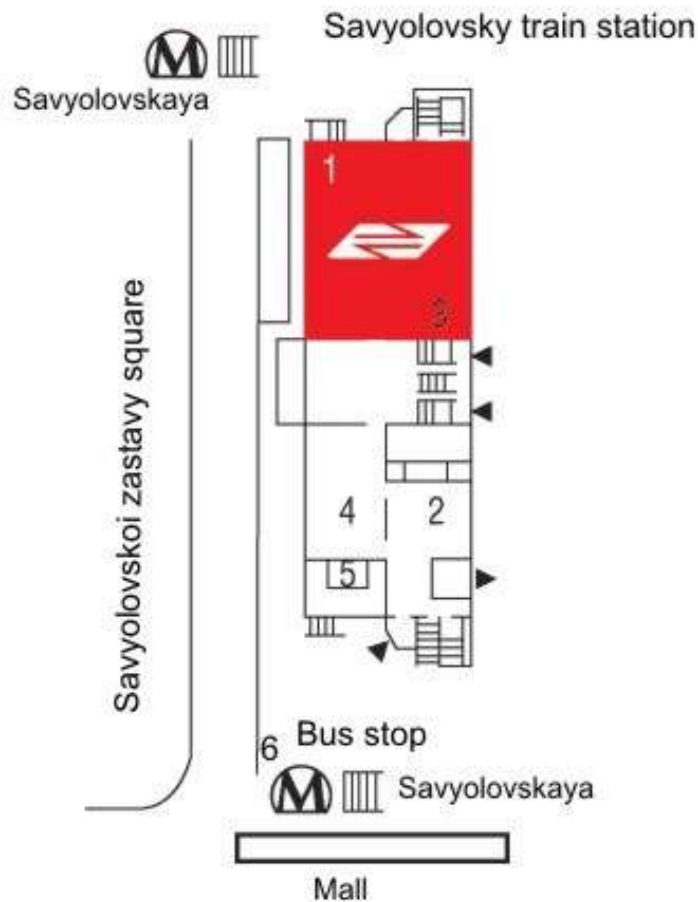
This instruction is intended for people who will get to Dubna from the airports near Moscow (Sheremetievo or Domodedovo) by themselves.

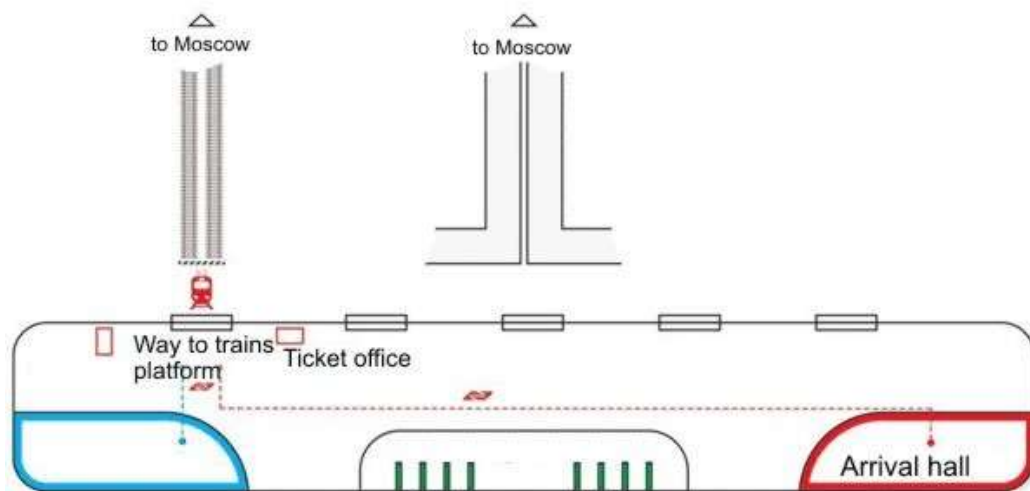
Figure 1. Belorussky train station.

1) If you come to Sheremetievo airport you should take an aeroexpress train to the Savyolovsky train station in Moscow. In order to do it, you should lift to the departure hall of the Sheremetievo airport by using the escalator in the center of the arrival hall and then walk through the passage (about 7 minutes) to the railway terminal which is situated near the airport. Then you should buy a ticket (250 roubles) to the Belorussky train station in Moscow and take an aeroexpress train (see the aeroexpress train timetable <http://nustar2009.narod.ru/Sheremetievo.pdf>). After the aeroexpress train arrives (in 35 minutes), you have to walk to the underground railway station (metro) Belorusskaya (on brown, #5 Koltsevaya line see the [http://nustar2009.narod.ru/metro\\_e.gif](http://nustar2009.narod.ru/metro_e.gif)), which is situated near the building of the Belorussky train station (see Fig. 1).

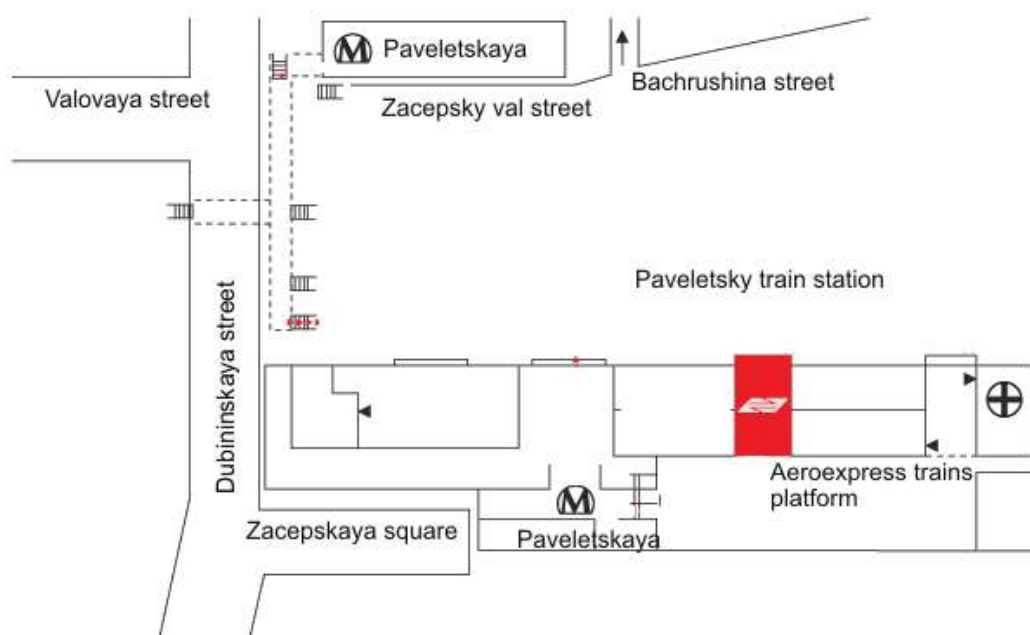
**Figure 2. Savyolovsky train station.**

So you have to walk to this underground railway station, go down inside, buy a ticket (22 roubles) at the ticket office, pass through turnstile, go down by escalator to the platform and take the train to the Novoslobodskaya station. Then you should transfer to another Serpukhovsko-Timiryazevskaya (grey, #9) line via passage to Mendeleyevskaya station, get train to Savyolovskaya station, get off and escalate to the city. Then you should go into the Savyolovsky train station (see Fig. 2) and buy a ticket to Dubna at the ticket office (5). After that you can go out through the turnstile (2) to the platform to take the train to Dubna or wait it in the hall (4). You can also get to Dubna by bus #415 from the bus station (6) (see the bus timetable <http://nustar2009.narod.ru/bus.pdf>, fare is 220 roubles, for buying ticket you should ask the bus driver).

2) If you come to Domodedovo airport you should take the aeroexpress train to the Paveletsky train station in Moscow. In order to do it, you should walk from the arrival hall to the railway terminal (see Fig. 3) and buy a ticket (250 roubles) to the Paveletsky train station in Moscow and take an aeroexpress train (see the aeroexpress train timetable <http://nustar2009.narod.ru/Domodedovo.pdf>).

After the aeroexpress train arrives (in 40-50 minutes), you have to walk to the underground railway station (metro) Paveletskaya, which is situated directly in the building of the Paveletsky train station (see Fig. 4).

So you have to walk to this underground railway station, go down inside, buy a ticket (22 roubles) at the ticket office, pass through turnstile, go down by escalator to the platform and take the train to the Tverskaya station (on green Zamoskvoretskaya line, see the [http://nustar2009.narod.ru/metro\\_e.gif](http://nustar2009.narod.ru/metro_e.gif)). Then you should transfer to another Serpukhovsko-Timiryazevskaya (grey) line via passage to Chekhovskaya station, get train to Savyolovskaya station, get off and escalate to the city. Then you should go into the

Savyolovsky train station (see Fig. 1) and buy a ticket to Dubna at the ticket office (5). After that you can go out through the turnstile (2) to the platform to take the train to Dubna or wait it in the hall (4). You also can get to Dubna by bus #415 from the bus stop (6) (see the bus timetable <http://nustar2009.narod.ru/bus.pdf>, fare is 250 roubles, for buying ticket you should ask the bus driver).
